Purpose

The purpose of is assignment is for you to carefully consider the holistic development and learning objectives that children develop through their free-choice play, as well as how teachers can enrich this play. To do this, you will observe children at play for one hour. Then you will answer the following questions **based on the specific play that you observed**.

Questions

- 1. In one paragraph, describe the children's play. Where were they playing? What materials were they playing with? What were the children doing in their play?
- 2a. Identify the domains of development that were nurtured as the children played, **and how** they were developed (e.g., what were children doing to practice skills in that area of development).
- 2b. Identify the academic skills (oral language, reading, writing, maths, science, social studies, religious studies) that were nurtured as the children played, **and how** they were developed (e.g., what were children doing that reflected that academic skill).
- 3. Suggest ways that a teacher/caregiver could enrich this free-choice play by writing specific questions or challenges that the teacher/caregiver could give to address the following academic skills. Note that this could be either within the child's play, or a subsequent lesson directly based on children's play.
 - a. Reading
 - b. Writing
 - c. Maths
 - d. Science
 - e. Religious studies
