Purpose

The purpose of this assignment is to design a learning activity using any of the teaching methods discussed in class. The learning activity can be for the whole class, small groups, and/or pairs of children. It can be for any age of children in ECE (0 to 8 years). It can be as short or as long as is needed to meet your learning objective. Use the Activity Plan presented in class to plan your learning activity. Your learning activity should be designed to achieve any one of the learning objectives below.

- Pupils will improve their fine motor skills.
- Pupils will improve their oral language skills.
- Pupils will improve their ability to count.
- Pupils will improve their social skills.
- Pupils will improve their science observation skills.
- Pupils will improve their listening comprehension skills.

Activity Plan
